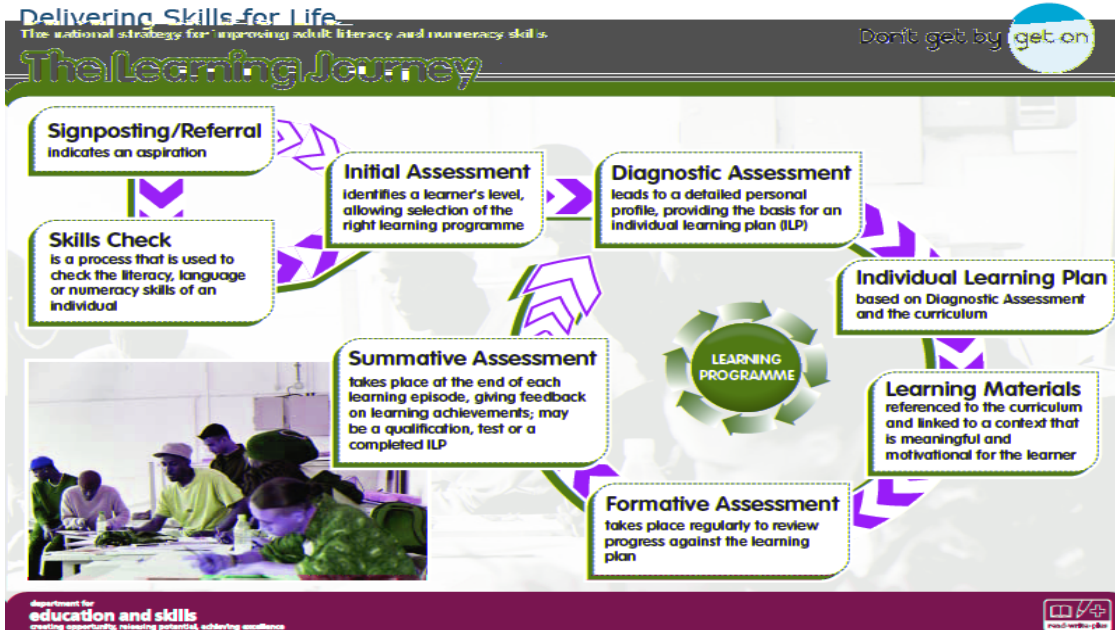


Skills for Life Strategy
